# New Enrolment 2019/20

The Education Authority (EA) plan to introduce new online applications for admissions to primary school places for September 2019 intake. A new portal for parents to apply online for a place has been created and this replaces the current paper-based application form. The Go Live date for the new digital admissions is Wednesday 2nd January 2019 at 10am. The closing time and date for punctual applications will be 12.00 midnight on Thursday 31st January 2019. As this is a new approach, the school plans to hold two additional open afternoons on Wednesday 9th and Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> from 2-4 pm. This is to support parents

with the online process and to allow parents the opportunity to tour the school. We would be grateful if you would share this information with any parents you know with children of nursery age.

Alternatively, parents are welcome to call into school any afternoon and speak to Mrs McGrath, if they need support with their application.



#### **Recent Inspection**

The ETI visited the school on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> November. Prior to visiting, the inspectorate was advised that the teachers in Dromore Road were following union directive 'to refuse to participate in any school inspection process'. The Principal and the Chairperson of the Board of Governors did however co-operate with the Inspection team in relation to the Schools' safeguarding responsibilities and the Inspectors met with a representative group of Y6 & Y7 pupils to get their views on school life.
